

CPP Agency Mentorship Program

Glossary

C.A.M.P. Apprentice Site

An agency that is currently being mentored to be a C.A.M.P. Site.

C.A.M.P. Site

An agency that has completed the C.A.M.P. training and is endorsed to continue providing implementation training in CPP to mental health providers within the agency as outlined by the C.A.M.P. model.

C.A.M.P. Mentors

C.A.M.P. Senior Mentor

A member of the CPP Development Team or a Senior CPP Trainer who has been trained to oversee a C.A.M.P. training.

C.A.M.P. Local/Regional Mentor

An endorsed CPP Trainer (National, State, or Agency trainer) who has been trained to conduct a C.A.M.P. training.

C.A.M.P. Agency Apprentice Trainer

A supervisor within a C.A.M.P. Site who has already completed an Implementation-Level CPP Training and is being mentored to conduct CPP training as outlined by the C.A.M.P. model.

C.A.M.P. Agency Trainer

A supervisor within a C.A.M.P. site who has completed the mentorship program and is endorsed to conduct ongoing CPP training as outlined by the C.A.M.P. model.

In general, when a C.A.M.P. Agency Trainer leaves their agency, they may only continue training in CPP if they join another C.A.M.P. site. However, experienced C.A.M.P. Agency Trainers who leave their agency may apply to conduct a C.A.M.P. training in a new agency with ongoing consultation by a C.A.M.P. Mentor..

C.A.M.P. Participant

An agency clinical staff member who is participating in a C.A.M.P. training as a way to learn CPP. Clinical staff who complete the minimum requirements for a C.A.M.P. training will be invited to be on the CPP roster.

C.A.M.P. Supervisor Participant

An agency clinical staff member participating in a C.A.M.P. training who typically has a supervisory role in the agency. The requirements are different for supervisors (reduced case requirement) because they often have greater clinical experience and may not be able to see multiple families given their role in the clinic.

C.A.M.P. Clinician Participant

An agency clinical staff member participating in a C.A.M.P. training whose primary role is typically to provide clinical services. Please note that the C.A.M.P. training is for staff members and not for trainees or those on internship.
