

CPP SUSTAINABILITY PATHWAYS

There are 3 pathways for sustaining CPP. Follow the questions below to see which sustainability program is best for your agency.

CPP Internship Program

CPP training components integrated into an existing comprehensive infant mental health internship program.

Intended for Masters or Doctoral students in their final year who would typically be ready for employment after graduation.

CPP Agency Mentorship Program (CAMP)

Sustained by CAMP Agency Trainers to train internal agency staff, following CPP training components, utilizing a customizable training format and timeline.

Intended for agencies with 1) minimal supervisor turnover, 2) supervisor availability to train internal staff, and 3) sufficient new hires to support annual trainings. Often a more expensive approach to sustainability than the Learning Collaborative (LC) training model.

CPP Learning Collaborative (LC)

18-month CPP training conducted by CPP Trainers on a regular interval. Training path followed by most community agencies.

Intended for agencies new to CPP or CPP-trained agencies who can access regularly held CPP LC's in their region.
